Vetrare Artistiche Toscane (VAT) is one of the world's leading stained glass studios. Situated in Siena, Italy, and run by brothers Gianni and Massimo Bracciali, it is also a centre for teaching the art, with students that come from all over the world.

As a Liturgical Consultant, I have worked with the studio for over 15 years but have known it since its inception more than 20 years ago.

The studio works with the classic as well as the modern form. Not many studios have artists that are able to paint to the standards produced by VAT.

When asked by a client for a stained glass window, I always work with them as I know that I will not only get the best that is possible, artistically, but that deadlines will be met.
